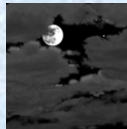
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure is drifting east but will continue producing fair conditions over the station into Saturday night. Expect cool temperatures, variably cloudy skies and isolated snow flurries throughout the period. Low pressure will move into the central Bellingshausen Sea Saturday night with snow returning to Palmer Station Sunday morning.
