PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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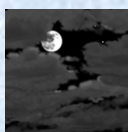
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure is hanging on over the western Weddell Sea delaying the approaching low and continuing to producing fair conditions over the station into Sunday night. Expect cool temperatures and variably cloudy skies throughout the period. Low pressure will move into the eastern Bellingshausen Sea Sunday night with clouds and snow returning to Palmer Station Sunday night / Monday morning.
