REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Little change in the overall pattern; low pressure continues to dominate the forecast for the next several days. Cloudy skies with waves of snow, occasionally mixed with sleet, will dominate the outlook. Winds will vary in direction and strength significantly as troughs and circulations cross the region.
