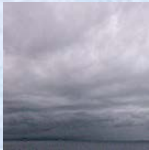
PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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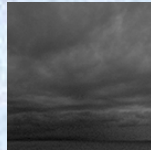
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure remains in control of the eastern Bellingshausen Sea bringing Mostly Cloudy to Cloudy skies and periods of fog to the region. A few breaks in the cloud are possible later in the day. Winds will be generally light southerly winds, turning NNE Wednesday afternoon.
