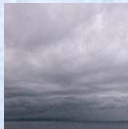

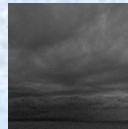
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Low pressure is deepening as it moves east through the Drake Passage. Easterly winds will be vary and diminish through the day as the system moves past, with periods of sleet and snow midday. Winds will vary this evening, then swing SW overnight with temperatures dropping and snow for Thursday.
