PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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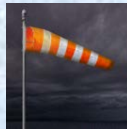
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure is building in the NW Weddell Sea, with low pressure sliding toward the English Coast, producing strong N-NE winds through Sunday. The associated front is dissipating as it approaches Palmer Station, but will still bring brief periods of snow, occasionally mixed with sleet during the period
