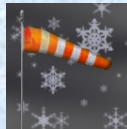
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A series of low pressure centers are moving over the southern peninsula bringing strong northerly winds with snow and sleet, heavy at times, today into late Thursday night.

Visibility (SM): 2-4 in Sleet and Snow. Occasionally < 1-2 in Snow

Wind (kts): N-NE 20-30 gusting 40

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2-4 in Snow and Sleet. Occasionally < 1-2 in Snow

Wind (kts): NE 25-35 gusting 50. Becoming NW overnight

Min Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -13°C / 9°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2-4 in Snow. Occasionally 1-2 in Snow

Wind (kts): NW 20-30 gusting 40. Becoming SW 15-25, gusting 30 by evening

Max Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -16°C / 3°F
