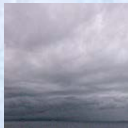

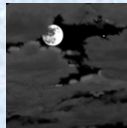
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A quickly passing low will bring a brief period of snow Saturday afternoon with high pressure returning Saturday night into Sunday evening. A new low pressure system will approach Sunday night bringing NE winds and Snow by Monday morning.
