PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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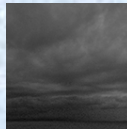
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure center has become established in the Southern Bellingshausen Sea, ejecting multiple troughs and minor low pressure circulations over the northern peninsula. Expect cloudy skies with northeast winds and bands of snow showers diminishing through the day.
