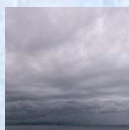
PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure northeast of Palmer and a line of low pressure centers extend from southern Chile into the southeast Bellingshausen Sea. Northerly winds will strengthen overnight with periods of mixed precip late evening. Winds will lighten Friday afternoon, then shift westerly with steady snow after midnight.
