PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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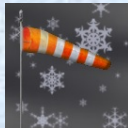
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure in the SW Atlantic with low pressure in the Bellingshausen Sea will continue to produce strong NNW winds and precipitation into the night. Winds will shift WNW and decrease overnight with precipitation diminishing Tuesday evening.
