REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Weak ridging following the previous low will allow for lighter winds and very light snow. In the late evening, another low approaches the peninsula causing gusty winds and reduced visibility to due fog and mixed precipitation lasting well into tomorrow afternoon.
