REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A cloudy, windy, and wet pattern is in store for Palmer tonight and Thursday, as a vigorous low pressure system approaches from the west. It may be warm enough aloft for rain to mix with snow tonight. Temperatures aloft will cool slightly by early tomorrow, resulting in all snow. Precipitation amounts could be heavy tonight and early tomorrow.
