## REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Expect considerable gusts and lower visibilities today as a warm front extending off shallow low pressure to the west moves across the peninsula. Overnight, precipitation moves out, but a tight pressure gradient maintains strong area winds. Tomorrow, a double punch of warm fronts pushes through the peninsula as deepening low pressure slides south from the Straight of Magellan.
