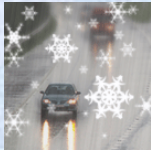
PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Expect considerable gusts and lower visibilities today as a warm front extending off shallow low pressure to the west moves across the peninsula. Overnight, precipitation moves out, but a tight pressure gradient maintains strong area winds. Tomorrow, a double punch of warm fronts pushes through the peninsula as deepening low pressure slides south from the Strait of Magellan.

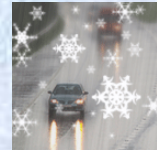

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Occasional ½ - 3 in snow and mist becoming unrestricted

Wind (kts): E-SE 20-30 gusting 40 becoming NW-NE 20-30

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Occasional 1-3 in rain/snow mix becoming 3-5 and then unrestricted

Wind (kts): N-NE 20-30 gusting 40

Min Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -7°C / 5°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Occasional 4-6 in rain/snow becoming unrestricted

Wind (kts): NE-SE 20-30, gusting 40

Max Temp: 3°C / 37°F

Min Wind Chill: -6°C / 22°F
