PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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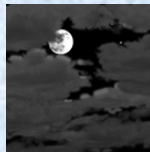
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A small but deepening low pressure system moves in off the Bellingshausen Sea today giving not much in the way of precipitation but winds could be gusty at times. Overnight and tomorrow, look for more of the same but winds should decrease as the pressure gradient eases and ridging builds in from the west.
