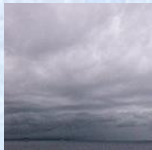

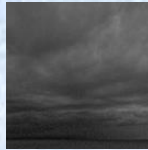
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low progresses towards the peninsula causing periods of increased winds, overcast skies, and snow showers starting in the late evening hours. Tomorrow, winds shift to the southwest after the low's passage and strong gradient winds and low level moisture impact the region.
