PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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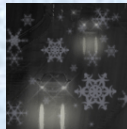
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The most recent low pressure system will move through the Drake Passage bringing a short reprieve. The next system will track more southerly into the southeast Bellingshausen Sea Monday afternoon. Conditions will continue to vary widely from relative calm with light rain to predominantly strong NW - NE winds and periods of snow mixed with rain and sleet for the 24-36 hours.

Sky: Mostly Cloudy to Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, w/ periods of 1 – 3 due to rain, mixed w/ snow and sleet late day

Wind (kts): Variable 7-12. Becoming NW 12-17, w/ gust to 25 late day

Max Temp: 3°C / 37°F

Min Wind Chill: -7°C / 19°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, lowering 2 – 4 in mixed precipitation

Wind (kts): NW 12-17 w/ gust to 28

Min Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, w/ periods of 1 – 2 due to rain mixed with snow

Wind (kts): NW 12 – 17, becoming NE 23-30 gusting to 35 afternoon. Brief gusts to 50kt possible late evening

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -5°C / 23°F
