**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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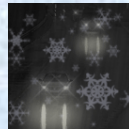
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Low pressure continues to track into the Eights Coast with a frontal boundary passing through this afternoon. A series of post frontal troughs will create variable conditions with cooler temps tonight and periods of fog Wednesday afternoon.

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 4 – 6 in rain, becoming 2-4 in mist and rain mixed w/ snow

**Wind (kts):** N-NE 20-30 gusting to 40, becoming W-SW 15-20 w/ occasional gusts to 30 afternoon

**Max Temp:** 3°C / 37°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -12°C / 10°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, lowering 2 – 4 in mixed precipitation

**Wind (kts):** W-SW 12-18 w/ occasional gusts to 27 afternoon. Becoming SW 10-15 gusting to 20

**Min Temp:** -3°C / 27°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -15°C / 5°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 2 – 4 in rain mixed with snow. Occasionally ½ -2 in rain and mist.

**Wind (kts):** NW 10-15, veering NW 18-25 gusting 35 midday

**Max Temp:** 3°C / 37°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -9°C / 16°F
