PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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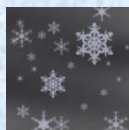
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

W-NW winds ahead of a front associated with low pressure in the Bellingshausen Sea will bring steady, occasionally heavy, snow to the station today. The low center will pass late this evening with high pressure building in behind it with decreasing snow and cooler temperatures overnight.

Visibility (SM): 2-4 in Snow, occasionally < ½ -2 in Snow and Blowing Snow

Wind (kts): W-NW 13-18, gusting 28, backing SW late afternoon

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2-4 in Snow, occasionally lowering < ½ -2 in Blowing Snow, becoming Unrestricted overnight

Wind (kts):): SW 13-18 gusting 25

Min Temp: -8°C / 18°F

Min Wind Chill: -18°C / 0°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted.

Wind (kts): S-SW 15-20 gusting 25
