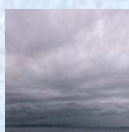
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Cloudiness will increase today as high pressure ridging moves east ahead of the next front approaching overnight. Cool temps early today will warm slightly into the evening with snow and mist beginning overnight. Light winds with snow showers will prevail Tuesday, becoming heavier into Wednesday.
