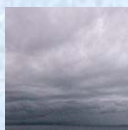
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

A front will clear the peninsula today with precipitation diminishing after noon. A brief dry period this afternoon will end overnight. Winds will shift to the NW Thursday with warming temps and snow increasing Thursday afternoon.
