REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure to the NE of the Palmer Peninsula is pushing the storm track into the western Bellingshausen Sea. Northerly winds will continue to bring warmer than typical temperatures, with periods of mixed precipitation this afternoon and evening. Monday will be drier with winds subsiding slightly.
