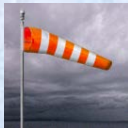
PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure in the Bellingshausen Sea and associated fronts are finally moving east across the Palmer Peninsula. Strong NW winds, and snow mixed with rain will persist throughout today, overnight and into midday Friday.
