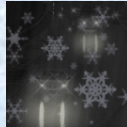
### REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure will cross the region bringing NW winds, cloud and snow today. Winds will back to the SW and become light Sunday evening, with clouds decreasing overnight as high pressure builds into the western Bellingshausen Sea. Southerly winds will increase Monday, becoming S-SE'erly Monday afternoon into Tuesday afternoon
