## PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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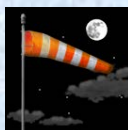
### REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure building into the south western Bellingshausen Sea, in conjunction with deepening low pressure north east of the Palmer Peninsula, will produce clearing skies, strong SE'erly winds and cold temperatures Tuesday into Wednesday night.
