High pressure in the Bellingshausen Sea is interacting with a split low pressure system over the region, with the primary center in the Weddell Ice Sea, and a smaller low center to the north of Palmer Station. Mostly to partly cloudy skies, with occasional snow showers and cold SE'erly winds will continue through the forecast period.
