Moist flow continues from the northwest as Low pressure remains in the Amundsen Sea region throughout the period. This will continue to cause periods of fairly decent weather mixed in with pretty darn ugly weather through tomorrow. There will be several periods of decreased visibility in snow/rain beginning this morning, another after midnight tonight, and again tomorrow late afternoon into the evening hours. The stronger winds are expected this morning and again tomorrow late morning into the evening timeframe.
