**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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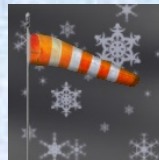
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Low pressure digging into the Bellingshausen Sea region again this morning will bring a couple of waves of precipitation once again. The first batch will be late this morning into early evening, the second is late tonight into the mid morning hours tomorrow, with the snow tapering off late morning. Breezy conditions through most of the period, with temperatures cooling off tomorrow.

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, w/ periods of 2-4 snow/rain mix beginning late morning

**Wind (kts):** N-NE 15-30 w/ isolated gusts to 40

**Min Wind Chill:** -6°C / 21°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, occasional periods of 4-6 due to snow

**Wind (kts):** NW-NNE 10-20, becoming SW-W 10-20 w/ gusts to 25

**Min Temp:** 0°C / 32°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -5°C / 23°F

**Sky:** Cloudy to Mostly Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, w/ periods of 3-5 due to snow early morning

**Wind (kts):** SW-W 10-20 w/ gusts to 25, becoming NW-NE 6-12 late night

**Max Temp:** 0°C / 32°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -6°C / 21°F
