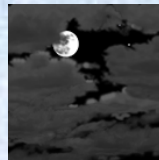
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure pulling off to the east this morning as a ridge of High pressure builds in from the west-northwest, bringing overall decent conditions. Next Low passes just to the north tonight on its eastward trek, so a chance for light snow will remain in the forecast. Weak troughing along the western side of the Peninsula will keep an occasional snow flurry or two in the area for Saturday, but nothing to significantly lower the visibility. Temperatures remain on the cool side throughout the period.

Sky: Cloudy becoming Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional 4-6 due to light snow

Wind (kts): W-NW 10-15, becoming NW 5-10

Max Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy to Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, w/ light snow in the vicinity

Wind (kts): N-NE 5-10

Min Temp: -3°C / 27°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F

Sky: Partly Cloudy becoming Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, possible 4-6 due to light snow

Wind (kts): NE 4-8, becoming light / variable

Max Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F
