REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure rapidly approaching from the northwest today, bringing another bout of strong winds that will continue into Thursday, and an influx of moisture for most of the period as well. Conditions will rapidly deteriorate by late morning/early afternoon as a warm frontal boundary pushes through the area, with visibility finally improving by mid-morning on Wednesday. Next round of precipitation moves in around midnight on Wednesday as a cold frontal boundary sweeps in from the west-northwest, with deteriorating conditions once again into Thursday afternoon.
