**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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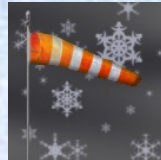
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Strong northwesterly flow continues over the area as Low pressure pulls off rapidly to the southeast of the Peninsula this morning, but with greatly improved visibility over the area. The next wave of precipitation rolls in around midnight tonight dropping visibility hard once again, continuing into late morning on Thursday before slowly improving throughout the day on Thursday as the snow tapers off.

**Sky:** Cloudy to Mostly Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, light snow lingering in the vicinity early morning hours

**Wind (kts):** NW-N 20-35 w/ gusts to 40

**Min Wind Chill:** -7°C / 19°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, becoming 1-3 due to snow by midnight, 1/2-2 after midnight

**Wind (kts):** N 25-45 w/ gusts to 60

**Min Temp:** 1°C / 34°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -8°C / 18°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 1/2-2 due to snow, w/ periods of 3-5, becoming 5-7 late afternoon

**Wind (kts):** NW-N 30-45 w/ gusts to 60, becoming 25-35 w/ gusts to 45 during the afternoon

**Max Temp:** 2°C / 36°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -8°C / 18°F
