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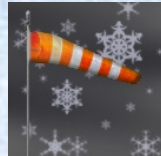
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure in the Bellingshausen Sea continues to punish the peninsula with clouds, wind, and precipitation as a cold front crashes the area this morning. Expect wind speeds to taper off through tomorrow morning, increasing again tomorrow evening as the next frontal system approaches...
