PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure moving across the southern portion of the Peninsula drags a weak cold frontal boundary with it, keeping a strong northwest-northerly wind flow over the region, along with periods of reduced visibility in snow. The winds ease up overnight tonight as the Low slips off to the southeast, but periods of light snow remain in the area through midday on Sunday, when a ridge of High pressure builds in over the area from the northwest, bringing extensive fog into the region through Sunday night.

Visibility (SM): 3/4-2 due to snow, becoming Unrestricted mid-late afternoon

Wind (kts): NW-N 35-50 w/ gusts to 55, becoming NW 20-30 w/ gusts to 40

Max Temp: 3°C / 37°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted w/ occasional light snow, brief periods of 2-4 possible

Wind (kts): NW-N 20-35 w/ gusts to 40, becoming 15-25

Min Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F

Sky: Cloudy, occasional Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted w/ occasional light snow till noon, becoming 1-3 due to fog by late afternoon

Wind (kts): NW-N 15-25, becoming S-SW 5-15 late afternoon

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F
