**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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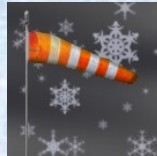
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Decent weather today with plenty of sun and light winds as a ridge of High pressure continues to build over the area from the northwest. The next system rolls in early this evening with another batch of precipitation and strengthened winds continuing through the night. Winds will diminish and snow will taper off by late morning / early afternoon. Another Low passes just north of Anvers Island on Tuesday night, with possible light snow moving through the area once again, but luckily the majority of the punch with this system will remain to the north.
