**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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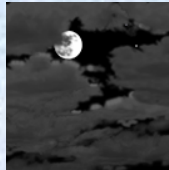
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Mostly cloudy with some light snow still hanging along the western Peninsula coastline this morning as the Low moving east through the Weddell Sea swings a weak trough up through the Anvers Island region. Beautiful weather with decreasing cloudiness throughout the day, along with light winds. Increased clouds expected tonight as a ridge of High pressure builds in briefly over the area, with the next system approaching from the west tomorrow with an increase in the winds once again and another dose of snow.
