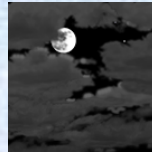
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Winds swing to the southwest this evening with increasing clouds overnight through tomorrow as strong high pressure extends south into the Bellingshausen Sea from the South Pacific. Expect periods of light snow by tomorrow afternoon...
