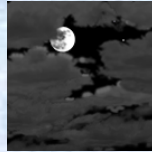
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Weak Low pressure situated just north of Anvers Island this morning will bring light snow over the area this morning as it pulls off to the east, with very light winds as well.
