**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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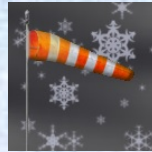
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Low pressure working towards the Drake Passage from the west-northwest this morning, bringing a frontal boundary swinging down over Anvers Island from the north. Cloudy skies, occasional gusty winds and periods of reduced visibility in light snow and mist remain over the region into tomorrow morning as the Low moves into the Drake. Monday brings decreasing cloudiness and diminishing winds as the Low pulls off to the east, allowing weak High pressure to finally work back in over the area.

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, w/ periods of 2-4 due to snow

**Wind (kts):** NE-E 5-15, becoming NE-E 15-30 w/ gusts to 40

**Min Wind Chill:** -7°C / 19°F

**Sky:** Cloudy becoming Mostly Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted

**Wind (kts):** E-SE 15-30 w/ gusts to 35, becoming NE 5-15
