REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Tightly wound low pressure dropping into the Bellingshausen Sea will slam a strong frontal boundary into the peninsula by this evening. Expect increasing wind speeds today with peak gusts in the 60's between 6 p.m. and midnight. Initial precipitation may be mixed-to-wet due to the deep, warm fetch, turning straight snow tomorrow. High wind and precipitation continue through tomorrow evening...
