PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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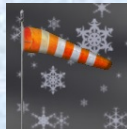
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure west of Anvers Island this morning will bring yet another round of stronger winds and periods of snow into the area, with visibility occasionally reducing due to a heavier dose of snow. This pattern looks to continue through the weekend.
