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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

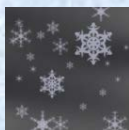
Weak troughing along the western side of the Peninsula will keep periods of light snow in the area through this morning. A major Low develops to the northwest and moves into the Drake Passage this evening, bringing another wave of moisture over Anvers Island tonight into tomorrow.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, light snow possible through midday

Wind (kts): N-NE 15 – 30 w/ gusts to 40, becoming light and variable late afternoon

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 14°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional 4 – 6 due to light snow

Wind (kts): Light and variable, becoming E-SE 10 – 20

Min Temp: -3°C / 27°F

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 14°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional 3 – 5 due to light snow

Wind (kts): E-SE 10 – 20 w/ gusts to 25, becoming S-SW 4 – 8

Max Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F
