PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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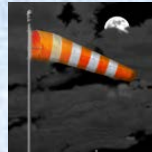
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure moving into the Bellingshausen Sea region today with an associated frontal boundary sweeping out ahead of it will bring increased winds and mixed precipitation this morning, with conditions improving by late afternoon. The next system moves in from the northwest tomorrow evening with another shot of moisture

Wind (kts): N-NE 25-45 w/ gusts to 60 possible, becoming W-NW 10-20 w/ gusts to 25

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 14°F

Sky: Cloudy to Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, w/ periods of 4-6 light snow

Wind (kts): W-NW 15-25 w/ gusts to 30

Min Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, w/ periods of 2-4 rain / snow mixed

Wind (kts): NW 10-20 w/ gusts to 25, becoming N-NE 25-50 w/ gusts to 60
