REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

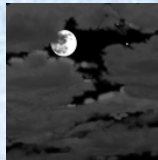
A weak wave of low pressure moves across the peninsula today with breezy conditions and reduced visibility in snow and fog...Expect deteriorating conditions from mid-afternoon tomorrow with high wind and reduced visibility by evening as the next frontal boundary wheels in from the northwest...
