**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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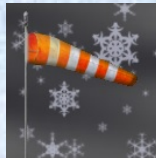
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

The pattern continues over the next several days, with numerous Low pressure systems moving into the Anvers Island region from the west-northwest. Each new Low will bring strengthened winds and wave(s) of precipitation over the area, causing frequent periods of reduced visibility in a mix of snow and rain.

**Visibility (SM):** 5-7 due to snow/rain/mixed, w/ periods of 1/2-3

**Wind (kts):** N-NE 15-30 w/ gusts to 35, becoming 35-50 w/ gusts to 60

**Max Temp:** 3°C / 37°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -8°C / 18°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, w/ periods of 3-5 due to snow

**Wind (kts):** NW-NE 25-40 w/ gusts to 50, becoming 10-25 w/ gusts to 35

**Min Temp:** -1°C / 30°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -9°C / 16°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 5-7 due to light snow, w/ periods of 3-5

**Wind (kts):** NW-NE 15-25 w/ gusts to 35, becoming 20-35 w/ gusts to 40 briefly late night

**Max Temp:** 0°C / 32°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -10°C / 14°F
