PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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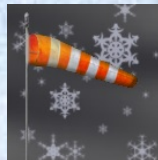
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Big ol' low to the west continues east and draws a bead on Palmer Station...Conditions should ease through this afternoon with breaks in the clouds and precipitation. Expect the next wave to plaster the peninsula with reduced visibility in rain and rain/snow mixed, and strong wind, this evening through tomorrow morning. Calmer conditions should prevail by tomorrow evening as the "eye" slides across the area...

Sky: Cloudy becoming Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional 2-4 rain/snow mixed, fog through morning

Wind (kts): NW-NE 20-35

Max Temp: 3°C / 37°F

Min Wind Chill: -6°C / 21°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-3 rain, rain/snow mixed

Wind (kts): N-NE 30-45

Min Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F

Visibility (SM): 1-3 rain/snow mixed, becoming Unrestricted, light snow

Wind (kts): N-NE 25-40, easing E-SE 12-22 late afternoon/evening
