A new Low is already spinning up in the Amundsen Sea region that has an extensive frontal boundary sweeping eastward into the Bellingshausen Sea region and up along the west coast of the Peninsula. This next system will bring another round of precipitation as well as stronger winds once again, with the snow continuing off and on through Saturday night into Sunday. The winds are expected to diminish slowly on Saturday morning.
