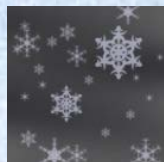
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The wind forecast looks to be a crap shoot as weakening low pressure oozes into the northern peninsula and down for the next two days. Flow should turn westerly overnight as the low center drops to the south of the area, cooling with a greater chance of fog and light snow...

Wind (kts): Variable 4-7, occasional NE-SE 15 through morning

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional 1-3 snow, fog

Wind (kts): Variable 5, becoming NW 7-15 by morning

Min Temp: -3°C / 27°F

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 14°F

Visibility (SM): 3-5 snow, fog, occasionally Unrestricted

Wind (kts): W-NW 7-15

Max Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F
