## REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Strengthening Low pressure approaches from the west this morning with a frontal boundary pushing out ahead of it that will begin to affect the Palmer region with strong winds and periods of snow by late afternoon / early evening timeframe. The precipitation and winds will taper off on Wednesday morning as a weak ridge of High pressure builds in from the northwest, with the next system moving into the area by midmorning on Thursday.
