PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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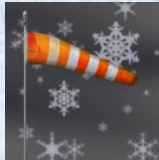
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Strengthening Low pressure approaches from the west this morning with a frontal boundary pushing out ahead of it that will begin to affect the Palmer region with strong winds and periods of snow by late afternoon / early evening timeframe. The precipitation and winds will taper off on Wednesday morning as a weak ridge of High pressure builds in from the northwest, with the next system moving into the area by mid-morning on Thursday.

Sky: Mostly Cloudy becoming Cloudy early afternoon

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, possible light snow late afternoon / early evening

Wind (kts): N-NE 10-15, becoming 30-50 w/ gusts to 60 by late afternoon

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -12°C / 10°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, w/ periods of 3-5 due to light snow

Wind (kts): N-NE 30-50 w/ gusts to 60, becoming NW 10-20 after midnight

Min Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 14°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 3-5 due to periods of light snow, becoming Unrestricted

Wind (kts): W-NW 10-20, becoming N-NE 10-20 w/ gusts to 25 late evening

Max Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F
